## Fifth Sunday of Lent

### The Schedule for Holy Week is as follows:

**Palm Sunday** liturgies at normal time;

**Holy Thursday: 7pm** followed with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from after Mass until midnight in the community room;

the prayer labyrinth will also be available in the old church all week during the day from 9am-9pm, on Thursday it will be open until 11 pm.

**Good Friday** will begin with a faith walk around Soldotna stopping at various points to reflect on Jesus' walk; to begin at O'Neill hall at Noon and proceed around town;

3pm is the traditional stations of the cross in church;

7pm is the celebration of the Lord's Passion at church.

**Holy Saturday vigil** will begin at 8pm; followed after Mass with a dessert extravaganza in the foyer.
