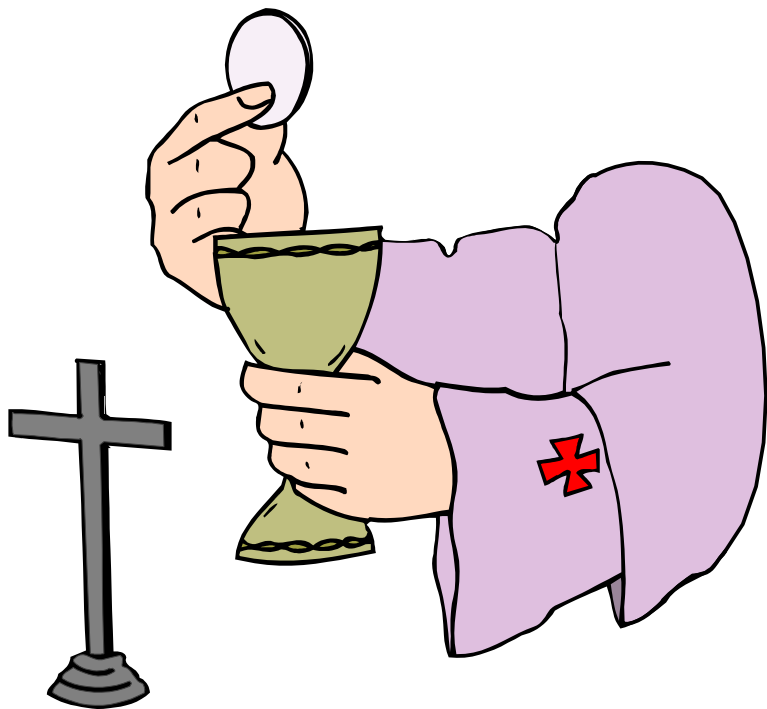


A LOOK AHEAD:

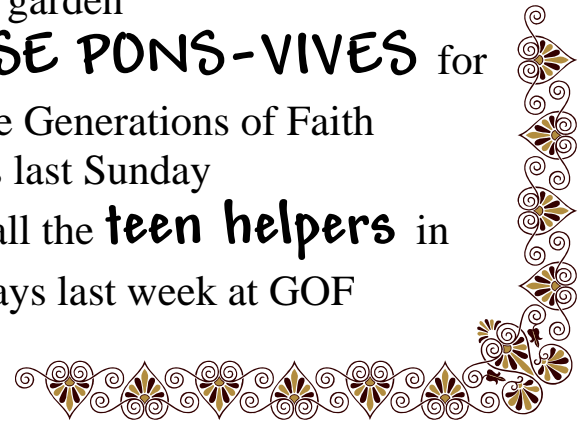
