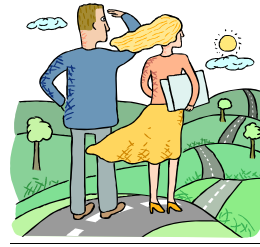
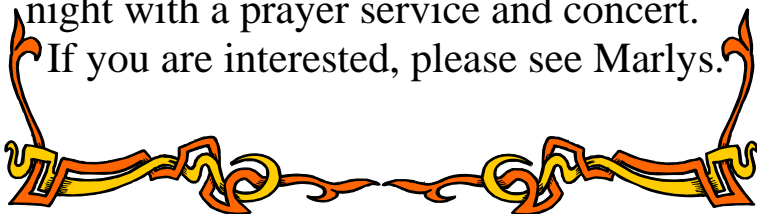

# IN SERVICE TO THE PASCHAL MYSTERY

Liturgical music is a ministry because it serves something beyond itself—the telling of the paschal story—Christ’s living, dying and rising for us. So musicians (singers and players) are, ministers of the paschal mystery. Music ministers are bearers of Christ’s story, Christ’s Word, to others. This workshop will explore how we can become better ministers of the paschal mystery. What must I know about the rites and the readings in order to select appropriate music? What kind of preparation is needed so that I am truly enabling the assembly to participate? If my job is to lead others into the paschal mystery, what is my own relationship to this mystery? As we explore these questions Bob will give many musical examples.
