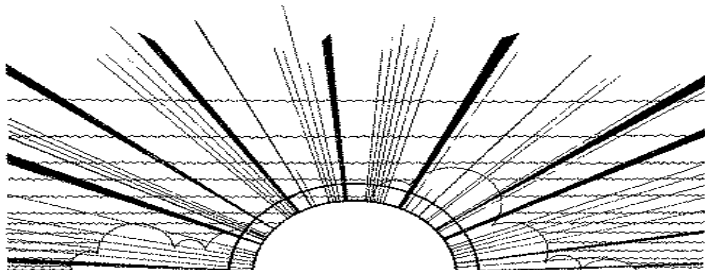
OKTOBERFEST
