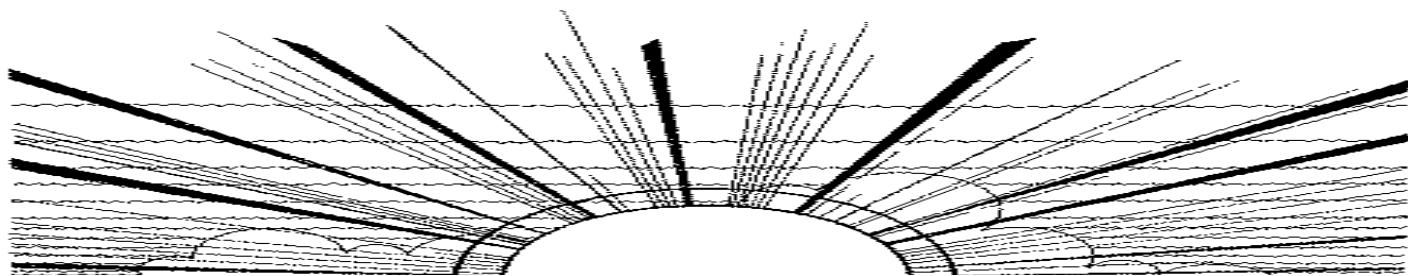

However, until then, **ANYONE TRAINED IN THE USE OF THE DEFIBRILLATORS ALREADY ARE THE ONLY ONES TO USE THESE, IF NECESSARY.** Please see that they are not tampered with by anyone else. We pray we do not have to use these, but we are grateful for the resource. Many thanks to Jane Fellman, RN and Janet Gleason, RN, from our Parish Health Ministry for obtain -ing the defibrillators and assisting with the CPR class.

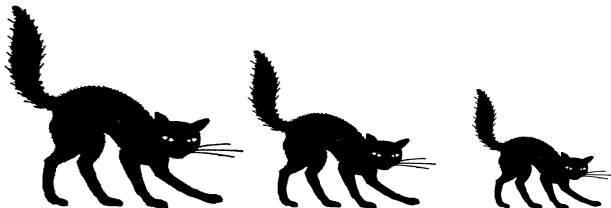


RAFFLE
