FAITH FORMATION

Faith Formation classes will begin next Sunday, October 2nd in O'Neill Hall for the grades of kindergarten to ninth grade. Children's Liturgy of the Word during mass is held for students between 4 and 6 years of age and will begin on Sunday, October 16th.

Registration is available after mass this week. If you have not done so, please register and pay the fee of \$10 per student for classes or \$15 per student in Sacramental class. Generations of Faith registration is \$50 per family or \$25 per individual for the entire year.

For everyone involved with Faith Formation classes and activities sponsored on the church campus, Safe Environment Training is mandated by the Archdiocese. There will be background checks every five years, online training every three years, and a yearly code of conduct signature requirement. Staff, to do this, forms are available in the church foyer. Please fill them out and return them to Marlys. Then go to the website: archdioceseofanchorage.org find your link for safe and sacred environment and log on with your name and password, identify which parish you are from, and you will then have 90 days to complete the course. After printing, please have your finished certificate forwarded to Marlys at marlys.verba@gmail.com. This is necessary for all ministries which are involved with children or vulnerable adults; including St. Vincent DePaul, parish nursing, youth ministry, homebound, and Eucharistic ministers
