HOLY COMMUNION REGULATIONS

In the Dioceses of Fairbanks, Juneau, and Anchorage the present regulations for receiving communion are:

1. Bow slightly before
2. Receive in the hand or on the tongue
3. While standing up, (kneeling or genuflecting is discouraged for safety reasons)
4. And, after receiving, respond with "Amen"
