## STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK OF APRIL 20<sup>th</sup>

"This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad." This refrain from Psalm 118 rings throughout the Church on this glorious Easter Sunday. His Holiness Pope Francis will echo that by proclaiming "He is risen!" from the balcony of St. Peter Basilica. In today's Gospel reading from John the empty tomb is described and emphasized. Although Peter and John, upon inspecting the tomb "saw and believed," it was not the empty tomb that they began to proclaim throughout Judea and beyond, it was the Lord's Resurrection. That is the reason for our joy. For us as Catholics and Christians this is the hope promised us by Christ.
