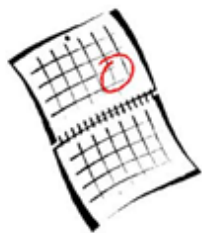

## STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 2<sup>nd</sup>

---

All Souls Day on November 2 is a day when we pray for deceased souls. These prayers may be general in nature or they may involve specific members of our families and our faith communities, including perhaps physically visiting the graves of our family members. On All Saints Day, we acknowledge the presence of those who have departed this life. Today, we recognize and honor them to an even greater extent. To practice stewardship completely we need to be aware of our personal families and our faith families. Just prior to today's Gospel reading Jesus reminds us that "I am the bread of life." Seven times in Holy Scripture, Jesus states, "I am..." followed by various statements which allow us to grasp more fully what He is and what He has done for us. Bread is considered one of those essentials "for life." Jesus is reminding us that He is essential for life, for eternal life. Jesus is not speaking of the physical life on this earth, but about "eternal life." It is that hope which allows us to trust in Him by living stewardship. This past June at Mass, Pope Francis said, "He Himself is the living bread that gives life to the world." Let us embrace that hope.

We know not the hour when God will call us home, yet our whole lives are lived waiting to discover what home with God looks like. Today's reading calls us to be conscious of our relationship with God as Father and Jesus as Divine Son. How would you express this to another, especially a child? Imagine you were in your last days wondering if you were going to heaven or fearful of what you have read of hell. How could you both calm yourself and convince another that you know and love God so fully, that you will be remembered fully in God's kingdom? Know this answer and live this answer in all you do.
