# **Parish Mission Statement**

We, the faith community, accept the call of God to participate in the mission of Jesus Christ by proclaiming the Gospel and living the reign of God among us as diciples

An Updated Lord's Prayer

Today's gospel reading contains the Lord's Prayer from the Gospel of Luke, which is less-known than the morefamiliar version from the Gospel of Matthew. The gospel today contains the words 'do not subject us to the final test', whereas the version from the Gospel of Matthew contains the words 'do not lead us into temptation'. These translation are both theologically problematic, as they imply that God has a hand in inflicting evil upon us, delibately subjecting us to the trials of temptation.

Pope Francis has recently approved a revised translation of the Lord's Prayer which will be used in the mass in the near-future. In this new translation, instead of saying 'do not lead us into temptation' we will say 'do not let us fall into temptation'.

Pope Francis explains his decision to alter the older translation: "It is not a good translation because it speaks of a God who induces temptation. I am the one who falls. It's not him pushing me into temptation to then see how I have fallen. A father doesn't do that; a father helps you to get up immediately. It's Satan who leads us into temptation – that's his department."

Pope Francis wishes to remind us that God is all good and is incapable of any kind of evil or cooperation with evil. God does not deliberately inflict temptation or any other kind of trial or difficulty upon us. Rather, he allows these things in order to preserve our free will even though we are sinners, as free will is necessary for us to return God's love for us.

The Lord's Prayer is the most-familiar of all Christian prayers and has been memorized by billions of people over the last two thousand years. It is a timeless prayer, but particular translations are the products of specific times and cultures, and must therefore be updated from time to time. Expect to change the way the Church says the Lord's prayer in the not-too-distant future.
