The Vanity of Riches

Christ's teaching is, of course, timeless, and in today's gospel when he warns of against the dangers of greed, his words are powerful even across the span of many centuries. There is nothing wrong with possessing money, which is a necessary thing for all of us. But we must all be on guard against greed, for it can overtake us even without our knowledge. The materially superabundant age that we live in can skew our sense of priorities and divert our attention from God, who is the source of all good things, and by whom we will all be judged on the last day.
