# **Parish Mission Statement**

#### Fortitude

Today's readings remind us of that practicing the faith is difficult. To be a follower of Jesus Christ means that we run the risk of rejection by friends and family members. The prophet Jeremiah was thrown into a cistern by his enemies, those who did not want him speaking the truth. Jesus tells us in the gospel today that he is bringing not peace but division, especially in our families. Yet we know that Jesus does want to bring us peace. But we can only find peace by surrendering ourselves to Him, and this is something that not all are willing to do. Consequently, we believers have division in the form of strained relations with those around us.

We know this division from our experience. How many of us who practice the Catholic faith and take the duties and responsibilities of the Christian life seriously have family members, friends, or coworkers who are lukewarm to the faith, or who are even hostile to the faith? These strained relationships are a tremendous source of anguish for many of us, preventing us from having the peace we long for. Yet we must obey Christ and persevere in the faith. The Catholic faith is not a popularity contest. Many of the Church's teachings are not popular with the general public today, but we know that they are true and worthy of acceptance and obedience because of the Church's divine origin and protection. Today's readings are a reminder of the cardinal virtue of fortitude. Fortitude is a strength of character that brings us constancy in the pursuit of what is good. Today we pray for the gift of fortitude that we may be stalwart in our faith despite rejection, ridicule and persecution by the world. - Fr. Patrick
